Fremont High 1st Annual Special Needs Basketball Game



Fremont High Business Department

Fremont High School business competition for students with the hopes that you'll extend this opportunity to your students!

- Teams are asked to provide a brief, 2-3 sentence summary addressing fundamental issues of interest to potential investors. Teams must also create a basic 90-second video pitch. Both should highlight the most important and interesting elements of the business that lead a potential investor to understand why your venture will succeed. Submissions will be accepted up until 11:59 pm on January 18th.

- Each of the **five** finalist teams will present their businesses to a panel of judges, the presentation time will be limited to ten minutes.

- The judging panel consists of entrepreneurs and other successful and knowledgeable business leaders. Judges will not be affiliated with, or involved in the preparation or funding of, any participating team. The decision of the judging panel will be final and will not be subject to appeal. The overall selection of winners is based on the viability and likely success of the business, including the quality of the overall presentation.
